The WPA project for housekeeping aides employed adult black women in need (by 1938 they composed 93 percent of the program) even as it confined them to traditional domestic work. Aide jobs went to adult women certified for relief employment to help in families disorganized by the absence or illness of the mother.

In 2004 domestic work was the second largest employment sector for black women in South Africa, employing 755 000 women (StatsSA, 2005).
