If I craft chapter titles that sum up the heart of the chapter I'm writing, but their message doesn't align with my premise, I know the chapters need to be rewritten or cut. In the same manner, if my chapter's position within the storyline I've defined presents problems with plausibility or continuity, it may also need to be cut, edited, or simply moved to a spot where it makes more sense.

Abstract. When you receive an invitation to contribute a chapter or section of a book, allow yourself 10 minutes to feel flattered. Then, read the letter again and try to figure out exactly what the editor or senior author wants you to do. Most invitation letters are rather vague because, for understandable reasons, the inviting editor does not want to give away too much information about the project before gaining a prospective author's agreement to participate.

Write the "Purple Prose" Out of Your Chapters. To write chapters that readers can't put down, start with a compelling hook or opening sentence. First sentences vary in their attempts to interest readers in the paragraph, page, chapter and book. Some first lines use description to build tension from line one.

Capitalize the first word, last word and all important words in each chapter title. Important words to capitalize include all nouns, pronouns, verbs, adjectives and adverbs. Capitalize articles–a, an, the–only if they appear as the first or last word in a chapter title. Place double quotation marks around each entire chapter title.

You should write the methodology chapter like a 'recipe' which can be followed closely by individuals who read what you have written. In short, Chapter 1 describes why the research question is being asked and Chapter 3 describes how the research question is answered. Note that there are several ways of writing Chapter 3 and the following is a suggestion on the sub-sections to include.
