Reader-response criticism is a school of literary theory that focuses on the reader (or "audience") and their experience of a literary work, in contrast to other schools and theories that focus attention primarily on the author or the content and form of the work.

1. Pay attention to what you are reading. It may seem obvious to say but it is not possible to give a robust response especially to something that you read, and you don't give it full attention. You should then pore over your text carefully, take the necessary time and then complete reading of your work.
