Modeled on Ovid ' s Ars amatoria ( c. 1 bc; Art of Love ), the poem is composed of more than 21,000 lines of octosyllabic couplets and survives in more than 300 manuscripts. Little is known of the author of the first 4,058 lines except his name, Guillaume de Lorris, and thus his birth in Lorris, a village near Orl é ans.

It is around 20,000 octosyllabic lines of French verse narrating the dream of a young lover, in which the long quest he has undertaken ends when he breaches the castle of Jealousy and obtains the rose.
