Before the story begins, teacher will have children take special interest of the illustrations on each page, as well as if they can notice what is different about this picture book compared to many other picture books, which is that there are no words included in the story. Teacher Notes by Robyn Sheahan-Bright - Walker Books

- Teacher asks if any of the students would like to explain how they think Jeannie Baker has created her artwork. This will lead to the discussion on collage and what it is so we can begin our own collage.
- Finalize lesson by explaining to the class they have now explored some of Jeannie Baker's artwork and next lesson we are creating our own.

lesson 1 art - Jeannie Baker

Teaching Notes • Jeannie Baker's artwork presents a very hopeful view of the future. Create two different views of the future 50 years from now—one in a positive way and the other in a negative way. Get the class into groups to discuss their views of the future. Think about

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how the future is represented in popular culture.
